



Featured Scholars are chosen from the general TED membership. These scholars are selected because of their innovative work in special education teacher education. If you are interested in sharing your work with the constituency of the Teacher Education Division in an innovative means of dissemination, apply to be a TED Featured Scholar today!

Featured scholars will share a synopsis of their work either via podcast (i.e. an audio recording) or vodcast (i.e. a video recording) on this TED website. For a period of two to three months following the pod or vodcast, the Featured Scholar will monitor a blog, facilitating discussion and feedback about the featured research, commentary, review, etc.

Featured Scholars will be selected by the Professional Development Committee of TED based on a review of the following criteria:

- Applicant is a current member of TED;
- Applicant is currently involved in knowledge generation and dissemination in special education teacher education;
- Timeliness of the proposed topic (potential for scholarly contribution to the special education teacher education);
- Willingness to pod/vodcast and monitor blog (technical assistance will be provided).
